A Faculty Senate recommendation to the Administration for the formulation of a policy regarding instructional materials that are faculty generated and faculty required for purchase by the students:

A FACULTY MEMBER NEED NOT SEEK APPROVAL OR REVIEW FOR THE USE OF ANY INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS THAT HE OR SHE REQUIRES THE STUDENTS TO PURCHASE, IF THE FACULTY MEMBER DOES NOT RECEIVE A ROYALTY FROM THE SALE OF THOSE MATERIALS.

HOWEVER, IF THE FACULTY MEMBER IS TO RECEIVE A ROYALTY FROM THE SALE OF REQUIRED INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS WHICH ARE PURCHASED BY STEPHEN F. AUSTIN STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS, THEN A FAVORABLE REVIEW OF AND WRITTEN PERMISSION FOR THE USE OF THOSE MATERIALS MUST BE OBTAINED FROM AN APPROPRIATE REVIEW COMMITTEE WITHIN THE FACULTY MEMBER'S DEPARTMENT AND FROM THE DEAN OF THE SCHOOL INVOLVED.
