**Resolution on Proposed Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Education
(Resolution 2001-02.06)**

WHEREAS, The Council of Deans of Stephen F. Austin State University has recommended the establishment of an office of Vice President for Undergraduate Education at SFA, and

WHEREAS, Establishment of this position would increase expenditures on upper level administration and support at SFA during a time when the university has made a clear commitment to address inequities in faculty and staff salaries, and

WHEREAS, The duties of the position, as defined in the proposal, are too broad and encompass widely divergent areas (i.e., faculty programs as well as those for students), and

WHEREAS, The duties of the position include areas that are already effectively administered without the proposed position (i.e., the School of Honors, SFA 101, and Teaching Circles), therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Faculty Senate does not endorse the establishment of an Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Education.
