



### Aviation Program Costs Disclosure

The Aviation Program requires flight labs which impose costs in addition to Stephen F. Austin tuition, housing, and meal plans. These costs cover aircraft rental, instructor, and other flight-based expenses. Payment is required within two weeks of the first day of class. We recommend you deposit \$3,000 into your account so you can start immediately, even if you are waiting on student loans. Not included are examiner fees, books, supplies, flight software fees, and fuel surcharge fees.
