SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Conference Proceedings Length

- Manuscripts should be between three to five pages (750-1,250 words) and double-spaced, excluding references, figures and tables.

Manuscript Format

- Use a standard academic font (e.g., Times New Roman or Arial) in 12-point size.
- Margins should be one inch on all sides.
- Pages should be numbered consecutively in the upper right-hand corner.

Reference Style

- We accept multiple reference styles, including, but not limited to, APA, MLA, Chicago, and IEEE.

PROPOSAL FORMAT

Recommendations

- **Introduction:** Half a page to one page
- **Literature:** Half a page to one page
- **Methodology (if applicable):** Half a page to one page
- **Results/Implications:** Half a page to one page
- **Conclusion:** Half a page to one page

Page lengths are recommended but not required. They should serve as a guideline, if needed.

Submission Format

- Submissions should be in .DOC or .DOCX format.
- Include a title page with the title of the paper, author name(s), affiliation(s), email addresses, and a brief abstract (150 to 250 words).
- Ensure that the main document is free of author-identifying information to facilitate blind peer review.

Originality and Plagiarism

- Submitted work must be original and not published or under review elsewhere.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring that their work does not contain plagiarism or infringe upon the intellectual property rights of others.
