GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

A meeting is scheduled in the dorm on Sunday night to discuss dorm rules immediately following last fundamentals rehearsal.

1. College classes are in session. Please avoid disturbances.
2. If friends come to see you at night, you may visit with them in the lobby of your dorm. Please personally notify a counselor as to your whereabouts; do not ask someone to tell them for you. If adult friends of the family or your band director come to visit you, special permission to leave with them must be given by the Camp Director or Head Counselors. Otherwise leaving campus is prohibited.
3. A counselor must accompany all groups at all times.
4. All cell phones must be turned off during all sessions.
5. Your room will be checked before you arrive and again as you check out. You will be charged for damages that occur during your stay. This includes damaged beds and bed covers, walls, furniture, or doors that have been marked on, spills, or any other damage of this kind.
6. You were issued a meal-card, nametag and badge-holder when you registered. Wear your nametag at all times. You should have your lanyard, with key and meal card attached, at all times. Should you lose either of these items, immediately notify the Head Counselor. It will cost you \$1.00 to receive another nametag and \$1.00 to receive another meal card.
7. No key deposit is required. SFA policy states that in the event of a lost or broken key; the lock must be re-cored at a charge of \$75. This fee must be paid before leaving camp.
8. All campers must attend all classes unless ill. Notify your counselor so that your emergency contact can be notified.
9. No resident campers are permitted in automobiles during camp. If you brought a car with you to campus, leave it parked at the dorm. You will be issued a parking permit at registration. You will be ticketed Monday morning if you do not pick up your parking permit on Sunday.
10. Your counselors are in the dorm to make your stay pleasant! Ask for their help when you need it.
11. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are permitted at camps. If there is any evidence of possession or indulgence in illegal substances, parents will be notified, and the camper will be dismissed immediately. **THE SFA CAMPS DO NOT TOLERATE FIGHTING, VANDALISM, OR ANY ACTIVITY WHICH ENDANGERS ANY CAMPER, SCHOOL PROPERTY, OR THE BELONGINGS OF ANY CAMPER.**
12. Stephen F. Austin State University, the SFA summer band camps and camp staff are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles. Be sure all your equipment, instruments and personal belongings are labeled and are not left unattended.
13. No rollerblades, shoes with visible or concealed wheels or hoverboards are allowed in any of the buildings on the SFA campus.
14. Confirm your ride home by Wednesday night.
15. Please vacate your dorm at the designated time on Thursday.

DORM RULES

1. Discipline problems are handled in only one way - a camper who cannot abide by our rules will be sent home.
2. Windows are to be closed at all times. Blinds may be opened during the day, but not raised.
3. Use the desk phones only in an emergency.
4. **DO NOT TAMPER WITH FIRE ALARMS OR EXTINGUISHERS.**
5. No more than 8 people to an elevator.
6. Mail received will be delivered directly to your room.
7. No food or drinks in the lobby or TV room. No one in the study booths. Do not play the piano. Do not move the furniture.
8. No loud noises in the dorm (rooms or lobby).
9. Always lock your room when you leave and at night.
10. Your counselors will have trash bags for you. Keep your rooms neat and clean.
11. Your counselor will wake you up each morning at 6:00 a.m. by knocking on your door. The counselor will not leave until you open the door and turn on the lights.
12. Campers must be inside the dorm at 10:00 p.m., on their own halls at 10:30 p.m., and lights out at 11:00 p.m. When you are given a curfew, stay in your rooms and do not disturb others.
13. Do not leave your room unless you are fully dressed.
14. Do not run in the dorm or any building.
15. When walking on campus, always use the crosswalks and never go by yourself.
16. Do not cause disturbances in the cafeteria. Campers are not the only people using the cafeteria.
17. Smoking, vaping, the use of tobacco or alcohol, vandalism, bullying and fighting are prohibited at camp. Campers who cannot abide by SFA Camp rules will be sent home.
