### Sunday, June 15, 2025

Noon – 3 p.m.: Check-In Begins

- Arrive anytime between noon and 3 p.m.
- Resident campers with Dorm Fast Pass (sent via email) go straight to dorm assignment (see above)
- All resident campers without Dorm Fast Pass MUST check in at Cole Concert Hall at the Wright Music Building at 2210 Alumni Drive prior to going to the dorm
- All commuters: Check-in at the lobby of the Wright Music Building
- Please wait to unpack until after auditioning

1 – 4 p.m.: Band Placement Auditions

- Lanyard name/badges are required at auditions
- All campers must audition for chair and band placement by 4 p.m.
- Specific audition rooms will be posted throughout the building
- Audition results will be posted in the Wright Music Building outside the Band Hall, Room 121, Sunday evening

1 – 4 p.m.: Middle School Informational Session

- Meeting runs approx. every 20-30 minutes, is located in the Wright Building in the Recital Hall, Room 160, and is an orientation and short “get acquainted” session. Parents are encouraged to attend!
- Unpack and set up Dorm (if applicable) before dinner

5 – 6:30 p.m.: Dinner at the Food Hall 1923 in the Baker Pattillo Student Center

- Dinner is included in the meal package for commuters or they may dine off campus – must return by 7 p.m. for rehearsal

7 – 9 p.m.: First official camp meeting and/or rehearsal

- ALL campers (commuters included) must attend, bring paper/pencil
- Commuters may leave after meeting/rehearsal

General Rules and Information:

- All campers attend all classes unless ill.
- The university does not provide health and accident insurance for campers. Any professional medical attention will be at the participant's or legal guardian's expense.
- For the camper's safety, there will be no leaving campus at any time during the week. If adults or a camper's band director visits, the camper will need permission from the head counselor to leave the dorm with them and only during free time. To leave campus, please bring a written note signed by a parent/guardian approving the off-campus activity.
- SFA classes are in session. Campers should not interact with SFA students.
- There will be no alcoholic beverages or unlawful substances permitted at camp. If there is any indication of a camper's indulgence in alcohol or unlawful substances during the camp, the camper's parents will be notified immediately to come for them, and the camper will be dismissed from the camp.
- Fighting, vandalism and other serious disobedience of camp rules may be grounds for expulsion. Parents of violators will be notified immediately to come for them, and the student will be dismissed from camp.

Activities and Recreation

- Swimming, sports and other planned activities in the evenings

Refunds:

No refunds given on or after June 15.

No deposit will be refunded after May 19.

All campers are expected to participate in the entire camp.

Fees:

As per SFA safety policy: In the event of a lost key, \$75 fee will be assessed to the camper for re-coring the lock.

Please keep up with the dorm key!

What to Bring to Camp:

- Modest, hot-weather, casual clothes
- Clothes for concert on Friday (Sunday best)
- A light jacket because the buildings can get cool during classes
- Water bottle or thermos
- Hat – spending some time outside during the day
- Comfortable shoes
