## Crime Log – March 2026

- **March 31–April 1**
  - On 3-31-2026, an officer was flagged down and advised their electric scooter had been stolen. The complainant stated on 3-31-2026, their unsecured electric scooter was taken from the bike rack located in front of Griffith Hall. There are no suspects.
  - On 3-31-2026, UT officers were dispatched to Griffith Hall in reference to a subject damaging bicycles. The officers found that the subject was picking up bicycles and throwing them from the bike rack in front of Griffith Hall. The subject was also found to be in possession of marihuana. The subject was arrested for disorderly conduct and possession of marihuana and transported to the Nacogdoches County Jail without incident.
