## Crime Log – April 2026

- **April 30–May 1 — No reports**
- **April 29–30** — On 4/29/2026, a UT officer met with a complainant at UPD in reference to a theft. The complainant stated on 4/23/2026 their Apple AirPods were taken from Kennedy Auditorium. There are no suspects.
- **April 28–29** — No reports
- **April 27–28**
  - On 4-28-2026, UT officers were dispatched to Griffith Hall in reference to a disturbance. Officers arrived and contacted the two subjects involved. After speaking with the two subjects' officers advised them they were both criminally trespassed from each other's residence. Approximately one hour later one subject violated the warning and went to the others residence. That subject was placed under arrest for criminal trespass and transported to the Nacogdoches County Jail without incident.
  - On 4-27-2026, UT officers served two arrest warrants on an SFA student for theft and credit/debit card abuse. These warrants were in response to the thefts that had taken place at the Student Recreation Center this past month. The student was arrested at their residence in Lumberjack Village and transported to the Nacogdoches County Jail without incident.
- **April 24–27**
  - On 4/25/2026, a UT officer was dispatched to Lot 43 to meet with a complainant in reference to a hit and run. The complainant stated on 4/25/2026 their parked vehicle was damaged in Lot 43. There are no suspects.
  - On 4/25/2026, a UT officer met with a complainant at UPD in reference to theft. The complainant stated on 4/25/2026 someone took their credit cards from a unsecured locker at the Recreation Center. The same suspect then used the complainants credit/debit cards to purchase multiple items off campus. There is one suspect.
  - On 4/26/2026, a UT officer observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed through parked vehicles and construction fencing in Lot's 42 and 43. The driver was stopped and issued a class b summons for reckless driving. There is one suspect.

- **April 21–22** — On 4-21-2026, UT officers were dispatched to the Student Center in reference to a theft. The complainant stated that between 4/20/2026 and 4/21/2026 property was removed from the information desk. A burglary of a building report was taken for this incident. There is one known suspect.

- **April 17–20** — On 4/16/2026, UT officers were dispatched to Lumberjack Village in reference to a fire alarm. Officers arrived and entered into the residence where marihuana was located in plain sight. One subject was issued a class b summons for possession of marihuana.

warning for all of SFA property. The subject was arrested for criminal trespass and transported to the Nacogdoches County Jail without incident.

- **April 15–16** — On 4/16/2026, a UT officer contacted a bicyclist on Wettermark Street for a traffic violation who he knew had an active criminal trespass warning for all of SFASU property. The subject admitted that they had just left SFASU property before the contact. The subject was placed under arrest for criminal trespass and transported to the Nacogdoches County Jail without incident.

- **April 13–14** — On 4/13/2026, a UT officer responded to Steen Hall to meet with a complainant in reference to a hit and run. The complainant stated that between 4/11/2026 and 4/13/2026 their unattended vehicle was damaged while parked in Lot 42. There are no suspects.

  - On 4/10/2026, a UT officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of University Drive and East Starr Street for a traffic violation. As the vehicle stopped the officer noticed the vehicle was occupied two times. Before the officer exited his patrol car the driver of the vehicle being stopped fled from their vehicle on foot. The officer stayed with the other occupant of the suspect vehicle. At this time the suspect has not been located or identified. There is one suspect.
