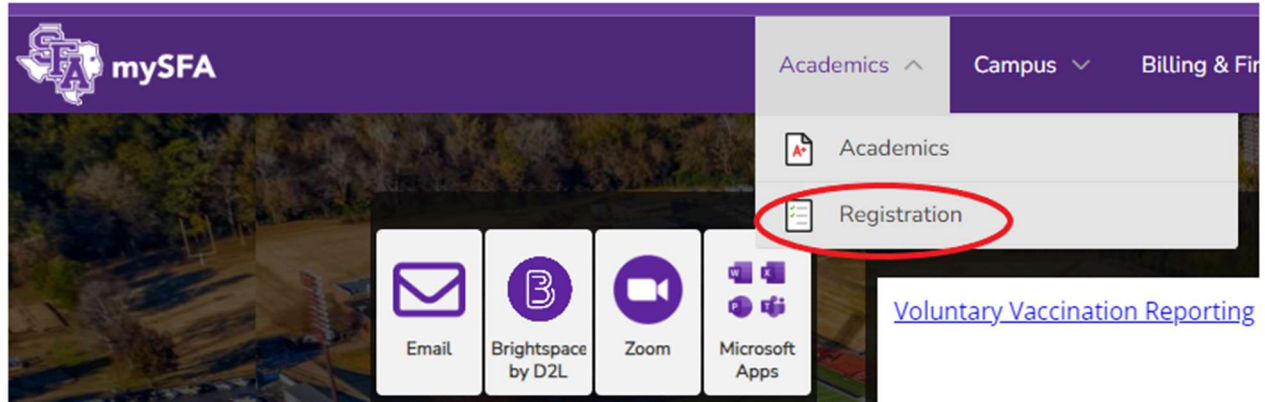
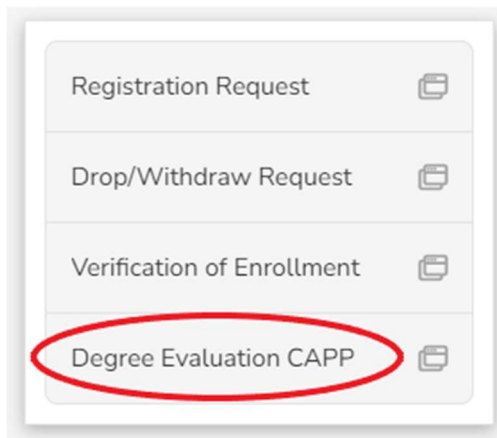


Running Your Student Degree Evaluation (CAPP)
