

Running Your Student Degree Evaluation (CAPP)

- 5. Your name will display. Click Submit again.


6. Your Curriculum Information will display. Click on the "Generate New Evaluation" link below the bottom line to view your current program's degree audit.





Running A What-If Analysis to View Other Degree Programs


1. Select the What-if Analysis link to view other degree programs.




2. Select the catalog term you want to use and select 'Continue'.




3. Find the program to evaluate and click 'Continue'.
