ELIMINATE GUILT AND EXPECT CHANGE

Some students might feel guilty about leaving their families to attend college. It is important to encourage them about the importance of a college education. CHECK IN WITH YOUR STUDENT

Schedule a convenient time to talk with your student in order to connect without adding extra pressure and stress.

A college education is more than academics within the classroom. Studies have shown that involvement matters, and students who are involved are more likely to feel a sense of belonging on campus.

MOTIVATE YOUR STUDENT TO FIND A MENTOR AND STAY CONNECTED

Encourage your student to find a peer mentor. There are many peer mentor programs on campus, such as through the Cole Student Success Center, Student Development and Access Services, college major departments, etc.

MOTIVATE YOUR STUDENT TO MEET WITH THEIR ACADEMIC ADVISOR

Meeting with an academic advisor ensures a student's success at college and will keep them on track to graduate. We encourage students to keep a copy of their degree plan of study, and keep track of their degree progression.
