SFA proudly provides veterans who have qualified disability ratings with a free on-campus parking permit.

Disabled Veteran: Any veteran who possesses or qualifies for disabled veteran license plates or has a disabled placard issued by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles and provides proof of service through paperwork from the Department of Defense or Department of Veterans Affairs.

Extraordinary Service Veteran: Any veteran who qualifies for or possesses specialty license plates issued by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles indicating receipt of a Purple Heart, Congressional Medal of Honor, Distinguished Service Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Army Distinguished Service Cross, Air Force Cross, Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross, or indicating service as a prisoner of war or survivor of Pearl Harbor.

Class DV: Qualifying veterans permit eligibility: Any person who meets or exceeds the requirements of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles to qualify for specialty license plates defined as extraordinary service veterans or disabled veterans by the state of Texas transportation code. The qualifying veteran is eligible for one permit restricted to the veteran's use.

There is no charge for this permit.

Parking location: Valid for on-campus parking where the veteran would otherwise be eligible to park with his/her existing permit.
