Fifth Semester of Program – Clinical Teaching: 12 hours

ELED 4242 – Clinical Teaching – 6 hour credit
ECED 4210 – Advocacy in Early Childhood – 2 hour credit
ELED 4143 – Professional Responsibilities Seminar – 1 to 2 hour credit (variable)
