- In 1920, John B. Atkins owned the property. A 1929 sanborn map shows that a residential house was located on the property.
- At an unknown date, Atkins sold his property. The next known owner of the land was the Church of Christ. The house served as a home to preachers.
- In 1963, the city directory lists Roy Cogdill living there.
- In 1964, the house was home to Rev. Robert C. Welch.
- In 1965, the house was home to Rev. Brooks C. Webb.
- In 1966, the house was home to Rev. James W. Adams.
- In 1970, the house was home to Rev. Oliver Murray.
- In 1975, Marlette Childs lived in the house.
- In 1991, the Nacogdoches County Hospital District bought the land from the Church of Christ.
- The house on the property was destroyed at an unknown date to make room for hospital expansions and parking lots.
