Jurisdiction of the Village of Nuestra Señora del Pilar de

Nacogdoches

Homes situated On the East Side of the Sabine River.

List of the families living in said Homes, formed by the Lieutenant of Cavalry Don Jose Maria Guadiana in consequence of an order of his Comandante, Don Sebastian Rodriguez:

Families

- 1.<sup>st</sup> sindico Don Marcelo Soto, Spaniard; occupation farmer, and age of forty-five years, married with Doña Marie Bayú, of the French nation, forty years old; they have two sons and two daughters, of 11, 3, 14 and 9 years, and three negro slaves, unmarried, of 22, 15 and 4 years; and five negro women of 40, 22, 9 and 4 years, and live in a home on the banks of Las Piedras Creek, 14
- 2 Pierre Lafitte, Spanish, occupation farmer, of 31 years, married with Louise Gañe of the French nation, of thirty years; they have one son and one daughter of 3 and 6 years, 4
- 3 Louis Beltran, his occupation farmer, of the French nation, his age of 50 years, widower; he has one son and one daughter of 9 and 17 years, 3
- 4 Doña Maria Ana de Soto, Spanish, of 42 years of age, married, her husband absent; she has three sons and five daughters of 16, 10, 5, 17, 3, 5, 4 and 3 years; one son-in-law of 30 years. Two negro women slaves,

- one of these married with one negro, also a slave, named Juan Bautista; one servant, his name Francis-cogerben of the French nation, his age 52 years, unmarried, 14
- 5 Vicente Rolan, unmarried, occupation field-man, and of 49 years of age, 1
6. Don Athanase Pueso, of the French nation, age of 28 years, occupation farmer, married with Mme. Jane Helena Pavie, of the French nation, her age 22 years; they have two sons and two daughters, of 7, 4, 6 and 1 year; also five negro men and five negro women slaves. 16
- ✓ 7. Michel Remben, of the French Nation, occupation farmer, his age 44 years, married with Theresa Mayu, her age 33 years; they have four sons of 11, 9, 6 and 2 years; one living with them, his name Joseph Crawford, Irishman, unmarried, his age 60 years, occupation farmer, 7
8. Charles Grullal, of the French nation, occupation farmer, his age 40 years; married with Gregoria Garcia, Spanish-Indian, her age 25 years, 2
- ✓ 9. Jean <sup>S</sup>alvador, of the French Nation, age of 40 years, occupation farmer; his wife Lenore Tessier, of the French nation, of 41 years; they have one son and four daughters of 5, 12, 9, 7 and 3 years. Living with them Jane, free negro, has one <sup>son</sup> ~~daughter~~, unmarried, named Jose of 15 years of age, 9

10. Joseph Tessier, French, occupation farmer, of age of 53 years, unmarried; has one negro slave named Francisco of 18 years, and of servant to Juan de Dios, grandson, unmarried, Spanish, of 25 years of age, 3
11. Louis Fortune, of French nation, trade of carpenter, his age 56 years, married with Manuela Aragon, Indian-Spanish, of 30 years; she has living with her her mother, widow, of 70 years; also a sister named Eugenia, married, her husband absent, and she has three daughters of 3, 6 and 6 years, 7
- ★ 12. Don Pierre Dolet, of French nation, of 40 years of age, occupation farmer; married with Mme. Rosa Dupré, Spanish, of 40 years; they have one son and one daughter of 21 and 15 years; one negro man slave and another negro woman slave, both married; also three negresses of 15, 12 and 5 years, 8

13. Andre Valentine, of French nation, and age of 45 years, occupation farmer; married with Angela Malie, French, of 34 years; they have one son of 13 years, 3
14. Mme. Marie Soto, Spanish, widow, her age 49 years; her son silvestre, unmarried, of 20 years of age; has one negro man and one negro woman slave, married; three unmarried negros; one mulatto named Jane of age of 39 years; she has one daughter of 7 years; and all the family live in the Nuevo Yatacé, 9

15. Helen, widow, American; her sons, Jacob Wallace, Thomas and Benjamin, unmarried, 35, 25 and 23 years. 4
16. Jacinta Gañe, of French nation, age of 25 years, widow, and has four sons and one daughter of 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2 years. This family and the anterior one live in the place named Navancha, 6
17. Francisco, free negro and servant of Doña Maria Soto, is in a house that is situated in the place called The Three Houses, and in that known as The Black Land there is another home where there is a negro slave called Louis, unmarried, looking after cattle of the citizen Don Atanacio Pueso, 2
18. Basilio Gañe, of French nation, age of 28 years, occupation farmer; married with Doña Marie Lafitte, she of 21 years. The first has two brothers named Rosimó and Jean Baptiste, both unmarried, of 16 and 14 years and a negro slave, his name Andrew, unmarried, of 25 years of age, 5
19. Michel Vicente, <sup>Bensón</sup> of French nation, occupation farmer, and age of 27 years; married with Helene Robleau absent, 1
20. Francois Prudhomme, French, his age 74 years, occupation farmer; married with Marie Ramben, French, of 42 years; they have two son and seven daughters of 23, 15, 15, 18, 13, 9, 7, 5 and 3 months; one negro slave and one negress of 45 and 59 years, 13
21. Pierre Rubleau, of French Nation, occupation farmer, of 40 years of age; married with Magdalene Bastie,

- French, of 21 years; they have one son and one daughter of one and 3 years; and one servant named John Malrone, Irish, unmarried, of 46 years of age, 5
22. Francois Morvan, of French nation, occupation farmer, age of 78 years; married with Anna Maria of Apache nation; they have three sons, one daughter, and one grandson, of 30, 20, 19, 22 and 5 years, 7
23. Jacques Christian, French, age of 80 years; married with Marie Dorothea, French, age of 50 years; they have two sons and one daughter of 17, 11, and 13 years; and living with them Juan Rivera, Spanish, unmarried, occupation farmer, and age of 30 years, 6
24. Louis, of the Caudadacho nation, of 30 years, occupation farmer; married with Madeline Christian, of 25 years; they have one son and three daughters of 3, 8 and 7 years, 6
25. Anthony Bouguer, American, occupation farmer, and age of 57 years; married with Mary Ann, English, her age 42 years; they have one son, unmarried of 26 years, 3
26. Andrew Boyett, American, age of 39 years; married with Sarah of French nation, and age of 20 years; servant, the first of Don William Barr, as also William Boyett, Joseph Bowen and Andrew Parr, the two first Americans and the last Irish, and all unmarried
