  - The methodology for determining SFA's executive compensation was determined by a Salary Equity Committee appointed in 2001 by former SFA President Tito Guerrero. The committee recommended using the CUPA-HR Administrators Salary Survey average of state and national public and private institutions in comparison to SFA's executive staff salaries. This recommendation was accepted and implemented in 2002 and remained the methodology for 2020.
- (4) Whether SFA's executive staff are eligible for a salary supplement:
  - SFA's executive staff employees are not eligible for salary supplements.

  - Market data from CUPA-HR 2019-20 Administrators Salary Survey
