

Evaluation of curriculum by Graduates Policy 2.2

Original Implementation: May 1996

Last Revision: May 2019

To ensure excellence of the programs of the School of Nursing (SON) and to assist with ongoing curriculum revision, graduates of the SON and their employers will be asked to participate in a summative evaluation of the program in the form of a survey. All program graduates will participate in a summative evaluation of RN-BSN Track program. Information obtained from the surveys will be used to enhance and revise the curriculum in all programs.

PROCEDURE

1. A survey will be distributed to all new graduates of all programs upon graduation to evaluate the curriculum.
2. A survey will be sent via email to all graduates of all programs six months after graduation to evaluate the curriculum.
3. A survey will be sent, six months following graduation of graduates of all programs, to area employers who have hired the graduates. The survey will be returned to the chair of the Evaluation and Program Effectiveness (EPE) Committee.
4. A survey will be sent 5 years after graduation to all graduates of all programs to evaluate the curriculum.
5. The results of the surveys will be compiled by the EPE Committee and reported to the Director of the School of Nursing and the faculty.
